CLUB MEMBERSHIP SUBSCRIPTIONS

Junior membership is £360 per annum and payments can be spread over 12 continuous months by Standing Order if you prefer. If your child has their own boat and you wish to rack it at the club you will need to add an additional £120 per annum (£10 pcm) but please discuss racking requirements with your child's coach first. All boats are required to have a boat identification number. Your child's coach can arrange this through the membership secretary.

If you are paying by Standing Order please set up payment on the 5th of each month. **Please use the surname and forename(s) by which your child is known as a bank reference so that their subs payments can be easily identified on our bank statements. So if your child's name is Brian Hughes, use Hughes Brian.**

Once your child's membership has been approved by committee (which sits on the third Monday of every month) you will be sent confirmation by the Membership Secretary. Therefore, please provide an email address which you can readily access.

CONSENT

1. I apply for my child to become a Junior member of Nottingham Rowing Club.
2. My child and I agree to read and abide by the Rules and Bye-Laws of Nottingham Rowing Club displayed on the notice board at the club and the club's racing terms and conditions laid out above.
3. I confirm that my child has no outstanding liabilities to any other Club affiliated to the British Rowing.
4. I consent to the use of video/photographs of my child for coaching purposes and to promote the club's activities.
5. If my child is elected as a member, the subscription becomes payable in the month of election.
6. I agree to my child taking part in the activities of the club and understand that I will be kept informed of these activities (for example, timing and transport details).
7. I understand that in the event of injury or illness all reasonable steps will be taken to contact me and, having parental responsibility for the above child, I give permission for first aid to be administered or, where considered necessary, treatment by a suitably qualified medical practitioner.
8. If I cannot be contacted and my child should require emergency hospital treatment, I authorise a qualified medical practitioner to provide emergency treatment or medication
9. I will notify the club and my child's coach if there are any changes in my child's medical circumstances or home and emergency contact details.

11. I take responsibility for cancelling my own Standing Order when resigning my child's membership and accept that refunds will not be given if I delay or forget to cancel.

Training generally takes place at Trent Side either on the river or in the club training centre which is next to Nottingham Forest football ground. Juniors who are part of the World Class Start programme are based at Holme Pierrepont.

BRITISH ROWING – RACING LICENSE

To enter a British Rowing event as part of Nottingham Rowing Club your child must be a fully paid up member of both British Rowing (Gold membership) **and** the club. Gold membership starts from £17 per annum. Membership of British Rowing affords many additional benefits from insurance to heavy discounts on goods and services. See useful links below:

RACING AND ENTRY FEES

Hopefully when your child is of sufficient standard they will wish to and be entered into local, regional and national races. Race fees vary from £7 to £15 per entry depending on the event plus a trailer fee which is currently £8 a trip (this might be more for further afield events).

IMPORTANT: If you wish to race in British Rowing events, you must be a fully paid up member of both British Rowing **and** Nottingham Rowing Club. You should initially deposit £100 in to the entries account and top this up as required. Nottingham Rowing Club reserves the right to withhold race entries if any monies due to the club are outstanding and/or if you are not yet a confirmed club member. Should you need to cease your membership of Nottingham Rowing Club any remaining credit will be refunded.

OVERNIGHT COMPETITION

In the event of a two day competition it cannot be assumed that the club and/or coaches/volunteer helpers are responsible for any minor (under 18 yrs) who wishes to camp/stay overnight. It is the parent or guardian's responsibility to ensure that suitable provision is in place. If by prior agreement, your child is to be in the care of someone other than yourself, a parental consent form must be signed and handed to the
